

# Ways to Pay for School

The average post-secondary student in Canada graduates with about \$27,000 of debt. But there are literally millions of dollars of funding out there.

## Before you go...

As early as possible:

- Start looking at **what** and **where** you want to study.
- Research **expenses** for your top 3 choices: tuition, books, living expenses.
- Compile the sources of funds you've already got lined up.
- Investigate scholarships, entrance awards and government loans so you know what's required for each.

### While you're there...

As soon as you're enrolled:

- ✓ Meet your Campus Financial Aid Officers (FAOs)— true campus heroes—they are dedicated to helping students find funding for school.
- Ask about campus work study programs (plum jobs that go quickly!)
- Enrol for any scholarship/bursary alerts at your school so you don't miss out on new funding that comes along through the year.
- Also visit the campus Career Center as they can connect you with part time jobs and career fairs. Many employers offer summer jobs

## After you graduate...

If you've got Canada Student Loans and/or provincial loans (e.g. OSAP in Ontario) you won't have to repay the principal for 6 months post-graduation, but interest may start to accrue—if you can, start paying back your loans before you graduate and during your 'grace period' to reduce the overall interest you'll pay (we calculated repaying \$250 before graduation will save \$130 in interest over the average 8-10 years it takes a grad to repay their loans!).

Even after you graduate, your campus Career Center can help you find a job. Sign up for their alerts and keep your school email active.
